Nomination Guidelines & Format:

In evaluating and comparing the credentials and experience of each of the nominees, the Committee will use the following as guidelines to make a recommendation for the Baltimore Chapter's Member of the Year Award. The Awardee must be a Lambda Alpha International member and will be selected based upon the Nominee's commitment to LAI, to the individual's profession and to land economics with respect to achievement in the private or public sector(s), research and/or education. Self-nominations are accepted.

Please submit written document (maximum two pages) outlining reasons for the nomination, using the following guidelines. Also include the Nominee's complete contact information, as well as the nominating person's name and complete contact information.

- 1. Direct affiliation with LAI at local chapter level? Other LAI Chapters internationally?
- 2. Specific initiatives and/or achievements that had a direct impact on growth, structure, and engagement of the Baltimore Chapter.
- 3. Professional career in land economics (development, management, journalism, planning, architecture, engineering, creating incentives for investments, etc.).
- 4. Specific achievements accomplished over an extended period in the field of land economics as a public official, leader, volunteer or advocate.
- 5. Extent to which individual is recognized as an expert in land economics field as exemplified through scholarly and professional writings; participant in conferences and meetings as a speaker, and/or leadership of organizations involved in land economics.

Award:

This award to be presented to the Awardee at the **November 16**, **2016** Baltimore Chapter's Annual Dinner.

In addition, the Baltimore Chapter Member of the Year Awardee's name will be submitted to Lambda Alpha International for consideration for the International Member of the Year Award.
